



HOUSING APPRENTICESHIPS

Funded Qualifications in Housing Levels 2 and 3

People 1st, in partnership with the Northern Ireland Federation of Housing Associations (NIFHA) are delivering funded qualifications in Housing. With these qualifications, staff can progress their housing career by learning how to work with colleagues and customers in a way that promotes safe, ethical and sustainable working practices. They will gain the skills to provide an enhanced service to customers by applying organisational policies and procedures - and once they have completed, there are opportunities to progress to higher level qualifications.

A Certificate in Housing is designed for people already working in the housing industry. For Level 3 qualifications, they should have experience in the industry and may even be working in a supervisory capacity. These qualifications are ideal if staff want to progress their career further, perhaps into a managerial role, or if they need significant training and development to meet the ever changing demands in the industry.

City & Guilds Level 2 NVQ in Housing and Level 2 Certificate in Housing Practice

Level 3:

City & Guilds Level 3 Certificate in Housing and Level 3 Certificate in Housing Practice

Essential skills:

Application of Number, Communication and ICT

Employers will receive an incentive of £500 for each employee who completes the programme.
